



NRCAN'S ecoENERGY RETROFIT PROGRAM

Natural Resources Canada's ecoENERGY Retrofit Program helps homeowners make their homes more energy-efficient and reduce the burden of high energy costs. Eligible upgrades include wood and pellet heating systems. Appliances purchased must meet certain requirements. Those requirements can be summarized as follows:

APPLIANCE TYPE	REQUIREMENTS
Wood stove, fireplace or insert	EPA or CSAB415.1
Pellet stove	Safety tested to CSA / ASTM1509
Wood furnace	EPA or CSAB415.1
Pellet furnace	Safety tested to CSA / ASTM1509

Grants offered under the program can be summarized as follows for each appliance type:

APPLIANCE TYPE	GRANT
Wood stove, fireplace or insert	375\$
Pellet stove	375\$
Wood furnace	375\$
Pellet furnace	375\$

Qualifying models:

The following PSG models qualify for NRCAN's ecoENERGY Retrofit Program:

Caddy Wood and Wood-Electric Combination Furnace
Mini-Caddy Wood and Wood-Electric Combination Furnace
Max Caddy Wood and Wood-Electric Combination Furnace

Caddy Alterna Pellet Furnace

Important notes:

All participants require a pre-retrofit evaluation prior to any work commencing. They must also have a post-retrofit evaluation and a signed grant application by March 31, 2012. Retrofit receipts must be kept. Evaluations must be performed by a NRCAN's licensed service organization.
